Architectural education in the museum and urban space Supported by the Beisheim Foundation

During the exhibition <WHAT WAS COULD BE: EXPERIMENTS BETWEEN PRESERVATION AND ARCHITECTURE> (5 April - 14 September 2025), the S AM Swiss Architecture Museum offers a rich educational program for kindergartens, schools, universities, institutions, and day care centers. The program includes level-appropriate interactive tours and workshops through the current exhibition, as well as tandem tours in collaboration with the Kunsthalle Basel. The offerings can also be booked outside of regular opening hours, providing a unique opportunity to experience the museum privately. In addition, walking or biking tours invite participants to explore the urban space. Introductory events for teachers offer the chance to get to know the museum as an extracurricular learning environment.

TOURS AND WORKSHOPS

THROUGH THE CURRENT EXHIBITION < WHAT COULD BE: EXPERIMENTS BETWEEN HERITAGE CONSERVATION AND ARCHITECTURE>

The focus is on the question of what role monument preservation plays today - and how it can contribute to the sustainable future of building.

HANDS-ON STATION: <HERITAGE CONSERVATION OF THE FUTURE?>

Pupils can record their own thoughts as voice messages at an interactive station using a QR code. The contributions become part of a growing public dialog - audible directly on site.

TOURS

The tour is geared towards school levels and supplemented with interactive and participatory elements. The pupils deal with monument preservation, architecture and future issues.

The workshop combines an interactive tour with a creative part: the pupils design their own cyanotypes - inspired by light, space and built forms.

DISCOVERY TOURS

TOUR 1: ART IN PUBLIC SPACE

Art in public space exists, moves, fades, and provokes. Sometimes subtle, but also loud and bold, these artistic interventions challenge our perceptions. This tour offers a new perspective on the familiar, sharpens the senses, and invites participants to explore the city with fresh eyes and new perspectives.
